

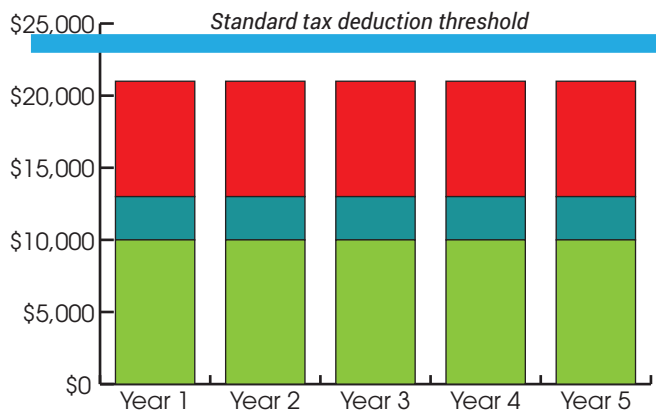
How to maximize your charitable deductions under the new tax law

Due to changes in tax law, maximizing your charitable deductions through bunching is a great way to support your favorite nonprofits while reaching the level needed to itemize the deduction for your benefit.

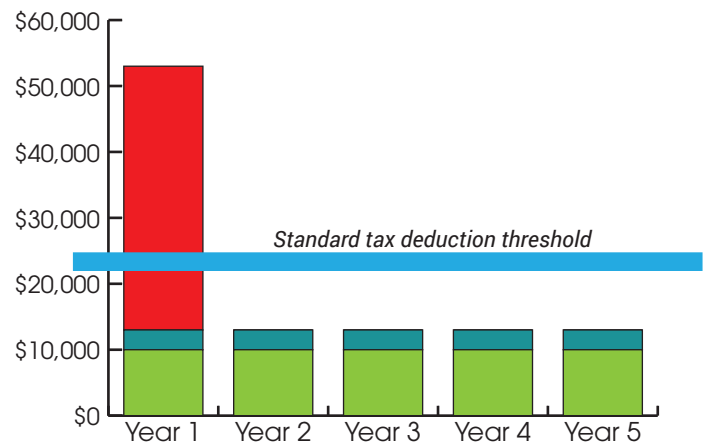
For example, say you make significant contributions to your favorite nonprofits every year, but now it's not enough to deduct them from taxes under the new standard deduction. If you bunch all of your donations for two or more years into one lump donation to a fund at the Community Foundation, you can still direct annual donations to your favorite charities, while itemizing your deduction in one tax year for your benefit.
